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La Palma Releases 2010-11 Annual Report

LA PALMA, Calif. – The City of La Palma is pleased to announce the release of the 2010-11 Annual Report. The purpose of this report is to briefly memorialize the programs and significant accomplishments that occurred in the City of La Palma during the past Fiscal Year. While the report is not an exhaustive list, it highlights the most important things that the City has done to improve the quality of life for all La Palmans.

Among the noteworthy, La Palma was again named one of America's Best Places to Live by Money magazine for 2011 and the City Council voted to keep the local Utility Users Tax rate at 4%; while also keeping user fees at or below 2007 levels.
