Summer Swimming Lessons in La Palma

LA PALMA, Calif. – The La Palma Recreation and Community Services Department, in a partnership with the Anaheim Family YMCA, is once again offering swimming lessons at John F. Kennedy High School this summer. Group lessons are being offered in weekday and Saturday sessions formats; with nine thirty-minute lessons conducted daily over two weeks for \$49, or four consecutive Saturday thirty-minute lessons for \$22. There is an additional \$5 non-resident fee per session. Lessons are available for all youth ages (6 months to 13 years old) and in various skill levels. Space is limited and in-person registration is required at the Central Park Office, 7821 Walker Street. Sessions begin on Saturday, June 15; Monday, June 17; Monday July 1; and Monday July 15.
