La Palma Police Seek Man Involved in Indecent Exposure

LA PALMA, Calif. – La Palma police detectives have released a sketch of the man who exposed himself to a 9 year-old girl who was on her way to school on the morning of February 27, 2014. The incident took place in the area of the Edison Right of Way, west of Valley View Street, near an apartment complex. The suspect approached the girl from behind and patted her buttocks, then exposed himself to her. The girl became frightened and ran toward her school; and the suspect was last seen walking into the apartment complex.

The suspect is described as a male Hispanic in his late 30's to early 40's, 5'8", medium build, with dark hair, dark complexion, dark eyes and a thin mustache. He was last seen wearing a light blue jacket, blue jeans, and a blue baseball cap. The suspect spoke with a Spanish accent.
