La Palma Police Seek Public's Help in Identifying Residential Burglary Suspects

LA PALMA, Calif. – La Palma Police are investigating a residential burglary that took place in the 5300 block of Athens Circle on Monday, April 29, 2014, at around 7:30 a.m. At least two suspects broke into the victim's garage, after breaking out a window. Fortunately, no one was home at the time of the crime, despite the early morning hours, and the suspects fled with a number of items. The crime was captured on the home owner's surveillance video camera system. The suspects are described as follows:

#1 – Black male in his early 20's, slim build, six feet, 180 pounds, light facial hair, wearing a black shirt with red and white logo, a white undershirt, a gold chain, dark shorts and black/purple Air Jordan tennis shoes

#2- Black male in his early 20's, slim build, wearing a black shirt
