## **Special Meeting to Discuss Residential Paint Colors**

The City Council will hold a Special Meeting on March 5, 2009, at 7:00 p.m. to discuss regulating the exterior paint colors of single family homes in the City. Results of the initial community workshop and survey will be presented. The meeting will be held at the La Palma Community Center, 7821 Walker Street in the Royal Palm Room.

The City of La Palma does not currently regulate the exterior paint colors of existing single family residential properties. Because the City received some feedback from the community about developing color standards to regulate the exterior colors of homes in La Palma, an initial community workshop was held in August 2008, to discuss this topic and provide residents the opportunity to give their input on the matter. In December 2008, the City distributed a survey to all single-family residents requesting their input on potential changes to the City's Code that would regulate the exterior color of homes in single family neighborhoods.
