Thai Senators Visit La Palma

LA PALMA, Calif. – On March 24, the City of La Palma hosted a delegation of Senators from the Kingdom of Thailand. The 14 Senators are members of Thailand's Senatorial Committee on Science, Technology, Information and Telecommunications, which is currently visiting the United States on a study tour.

While in La Palma, the Senators met with La Palma Mayor Mark Waldman and Councilmember Henry Charoen, a Thai-American who helped facilitate the delegation's visit to the City of La Palma. The Senators toured various City facilities and were very interested in how the City's water, sewer, and trash services are managed. Additionally, the Senators were impressed to learn about the City's low crime rate and balanced financing.
