Join members of the community to witness La Palma Mayor Mark Waldman throw out the first pitch and Kennedy High School student Jason White sing the National Anthem. Also in attendance will be graduates from this year's Police Interaction with Youth (PIY) programs from La Palma schools as well as participants in La Palma Recreation and Community Services programs, the La Palma Kiwanis Club, the La Palma Police Explorers, Neighborhood Watch, and the La Palma Chamber of Commerce.

The Orange County Flyers are a member of the Golden Baseball League and are managed by former Major League player Phil Nevin. Nevin, who is in his first year of managing the Orange County Flyers, played for the Minnesota Twins, Chicago Cubs, Texas Rangers, San Diego Padres, Anaheim Angels, Detroit Tigers, and the Houston Astros. He retired from Major League Baseball in 2006.
