FIVE ARRESTED FOR VANDALISM IN LA PALMA

La Palma Police arrested two women and three men for grand theft and for using a BB gun to shoot out the windows of several parked cars. On Tuesday, July 21, 2009, at 4:00 a.m., La Palma Police Officers noticed two cars parked in the 5000 block of Alder Lane that had their windows shot out with what appeared to be a BB gun. During their investigation, the officers observed a suspicious car with five adults inside. Upon stopping the suspicious car, the officers found evidence--consisting of a BB gun, ammunition, and stolen property--that linked the vehicle's occupants to the crimes.

Officers later located four additional parked cars with similar damage, two of those having been located by the Buena Park Police Department. La Palma Detectives are assisting Buena Park with their investigation to determine if there are additional victims.

Alyzza Dolores Cabrera, 19, a Buena Park resident; Britne Michelle Militar, 18, a Paramount resident; José Luis Garcia-Albarran, 18, a Bellflower resident; Fidel Zamora Jr., 19, a Norwalk resident; and, Juan Avila, 20, a Paramount resident, were arrested for conspiracy to commit a felony, felony vandalism, and grand theft. All suspects are currently being held at the Orange County Jail.
