## **La Palma to Test AlertOC on Friday**

*LA PALMA, Calif.* – On Friday, November 6, the City of La Palma will send a test AlertOC message to residents and businesses in the La Palma area. AlertOC is a joint County and City mass notification system designed to keep residents and businesses informed of emergencies and certain community events.

The Friday late afternoon test message from AlertOC will be sent to La Palma area homes, businesses, and those that have pre-registered for notifications from the La Palma area. The voice message will last approximately 60 seconds and ask participants to update their registration information at the AlertOC website. Participants are able to register up to three phone numbers and two e-mail addresses for community emergency notifications.
