Judy Yoo Crowned as La Palma Ambassador

LA PALMA, Calif. – Judy Yoo won the title of Miss La Palma 2009-2010 during the annual La Palma Pageant, which was held at the John F. Kennedy High School Performing Arts Center on Sunday, November 8, 2009. The La Palma Pageant serves as the official kickoff for the City's La Palma Days Celebration. This year, the La Palma Days event is celebrating its Silver Jubilee, recognizing 25 years of La Palma Days.

Miss Yoo, 17, is a senior at John F. Kennedy High School and resides in Cypress. Born in Seoul, South Korea, she performed a Korean fan dance for the talent portion of the pageant. "I am eager to fulfill my duties and take responsibility," Judy says of her upcoming reign. "I am confident that I can proudly display how special our City is to the world."

A total of nine contestants competed in five individual events. Miss Yoo placed first in the Onstage Question, Talent, and Speech competitions and tied for first in the Evening Wear competition with First Runner up Chelsey Wegener. Judy's court consists of Chelsey Wegener, Emily Kulassia, Mylene Montoya, and Danielle Jones. Judy and her court will make their first appearance during the La Palma Days parade on Saturday, November 14, 2009, which starts at 10:00 a.m. and travels along on Walker Street in La Palma.
