La Palma Citizen Committee Vacancies

LA PALMA, Calif. – Citizens of the City of La Palma are invited to submit applications for current vacancies on the Community Activities and Beautification Committee.

The Community Activities and Beautification (CAB) Committee works with City staff to coordinate City special events including Memorial Day, Concerts in the Park, and the annual Holiday Tree Lighting event. CAB committee members also assist the City in planning the annual La Palma Days event. CAB members meet on the second Tuesday of each month from September to June. The CAB Committee currently has one vacancy with a two-year term and three vacancies with four-year terms.
