La Palma to Host Meeting to Discuss Corner Properties

LA PALMA, Calif. – On Wednesday, March 24, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. in the Sago Palm Room of the La Palma Community Center, 7821 Walker Street, La Palma, the City of La Palma will host an informational meeting to discuss the City's plans to change the design standards to maximize the feasibility of six corner sites in La Palma. The City's objective is to encourage new retail and restaurant development on these properties by revising the list of permitted uses and allowing current innovative design concepts.
