La Palma City Council to Review Conceptual Site Plan for Central Park Improvements

LA PALMA, Calif. –The La Palma City Council will consider approval of preliminary architectural designs and site plans for improvements to Central Park at its July 20 meeting, which is scheduled at 7:00 p.m. at 7822 Walker Street.

The preliminary site plans are a refinement of the conceptual plan adopted as part of the La Palma Parks and Recreation Master Plan in March 2010. The designs include relocation and expansion of the children's play area, new shaded group picnic shelters, a water play feature, an exercise trail, a meditation garden, and relocation of the ballfield. The proposed plans are available for review on the City's website at www.cityoflapalma.org/MasterPlanDesign.

The City has applied for grant funding for the project and will identify alternative funding sources, if necessary, once the site plan is approved and construction documents are complete.

Residents are encouraged to attend the City Council meeting to review and comment on the site plan.
