La Palma Police Seek Information on an Interrupted Residential Burglary

LA PALMA, Calif. – On Wednesday, March 30, at 9:55 a.m., the La Palma Police responded to a report of an interrupted burglary. Three suspects are being sought and are described as male blacks, all 20 to 30 years old, two were approximately 6 feet tall with thin builds and were both wearing white T-Shirts, with one wearing a brown bandana on his face and blue short pants. The third suspect was the driver of the suspect vehicle. These men were seen exiting a house on Thelma Drive, where they got into an older model, red Nissan Maxima. The Maxima drove away at a high rate of speed westbound on Thelma Drive then north on Walker Street. Responding officers found the kitchen window open and the alarm sounding.
