REGULAR ITEM


Director of Recreation and Community Services Jan Hobson stated that the purpose for this Adjourned Meeting is to review the exterior architectural designs for the Community Center project. She then introduced Mr. Jim Wilson of Thirtieth Street Architects to present a brief review of history of this project.

Mr. Wilson stated that they began the project by reviewing the existing conditions, staff and members of the Council were interviewed. Several plans and sketches were reviewed with the Council and a final design workshop was held to decide on the final scheme. Since that time the plans and exterior elevations have been refined for presentation this evening. He then reviewed the various features of the proposed design.

Action Taken: The City Council discussed the design features of the exterior of the Community Center. Ms. Standiford stated that she thinks staff has a general idea of what the Council would like to see and suggested that Mr. Wilson be asked to do some design modifications, which will be made available in the Mayor's Conference Room for Council's review. She stated that the Council can take as long as it wants because this is a structure that the community is going to benefit from for a long, long time. However, part of the funds are grant money and there is a clock for some of it and for that reason staff convenes on a regular basis to keep track of the many funding sources. No other action was taken.


ADJOURNMENT
